We welcome younger explorers for our Tech Tales program. Geared for kids in Kindergarten - 3rd grade.

Tech Tales (1.5 - 2 hours).

- a. Your classes will hear a STEAM based story read aloud to the group.
- b. The story is followed by a craft or activity that is related to the story.
- c. The kids will create something that they can take home with them.
- d. There will then be a short tour of our Space exhibit and/or Timeline area.
